### **Transition impact**

"The project has a high demonstration effect as the first turn-around and privatization of a large fully integrated former monopoly in Kazakhstan. It introduces environmental awareness in the region, stabilises employment and encourages the establishment of small and medium-sized enterprises.









"MST has repeatedly violated national environmental and work and safety legislation. The company does not provide safe working conditions for its employees and forces them to work on their free days, justifying the pressure by non-completion of the work plan".


