Procurement Notice No. 2/2008

Consulting services on the CEE Bankwatch Network 2008 campaign to reform the European Investment Bank, for the maximum amount of EUR 20,000.

CEE Bankwatch Network is planning to continue its campaign that seeks to reform the European Investment Bank (EIB). The Notice refers to **consultancy services** to be procured from an individual based in an EU country.

Specifically, the consultant selected and engaged will be responsible, in whole or in part, for the following:

- Providing strategic advice on campaigning to reform the EIB, including comments on various publications;
- Commenting on EIB policies;
- Assistance to the consortium of NGOs working on EIB-related issues;
- Advising on other CEE Bankwatch Network campaigns;
- Providing training for NGOs on matters related to international financial institutions.

Other activities of a similar nature might be requested during the contract period.

The Consultant will report to Bankwatch's Policy Coordinator.

Consultant Profile: An individual consultant is required with the following attributes:

- At least three years relevant experience working on issues related to the EIB;
- At least 3 years NGOs experience;
- Ability to draft documents in English to the highest standard.

Submission Requirements: Responses to the notification (not exceeding 3 pages, excluding CVs) are to be submitted in English by email to main(at)bankwatch.org, no later than the closing date.

Submission of a tender implies acceptance of the terms and conditions set out in the draft contract. The contract is made for the period February – December 2008. The contract can be extended, provided that the results of the work and services are satisfactory.

The **closing date** for the submission of tenders is **January 31st 2008**, end of business day, Central and Eastern European time.
