Procurement Notice No. 8/2008

Director for the production of a documentary film on the EIB's lending in the global South.

The notice refers to **services** to be procured from an individual, a film director. Specifically, the selected individual will be requested to deliver a documentary:

- the film will provide a quick overview of the main problems and challenges related to the examples of 2-3 projects financed by the EIB in developing countries and will try to identify the main causes of the weaknesses of these projects. The film will also give voice to southern groups willing to share ideas on how to improve their living conditions;
- a documentary that can be viewed by all - professionals involved in development and EIB issues as well as interested citizens or civil society groups;
- the documentary will be presented during networks meetings, festivals, as an introductory tool to open a public debate, and will also be distributed in development resource centres. It is planned as an outreach tool to bring people's attention to the complex issues of development and finance.

A full-length documentary film will be completed by October 31st 2009; a shorter version of the film that can be used for television screenings will also be delivered.

The film director will report to Bankwatch's EIB project coordinator, Desislava Stoyanova.

Submission Requirements: Responses to the notice (not exceeding 3 pages, excluding the CV of the film director) are to be submitted in English by email to [main\(at\)bankwatch.org](mailto:main@bankwatch.org), no later than the closing date.

Submission of a tender implies acceptance of the terms and conditions set out in the draft contract. The contract is made for the period July – October 2008. The contract can be extended, provided that the results of the work and services are satisfactory.

The **closing date** for the submission of tenders is **October 15th 2008**, end of business day, Central and Eastern European time.
